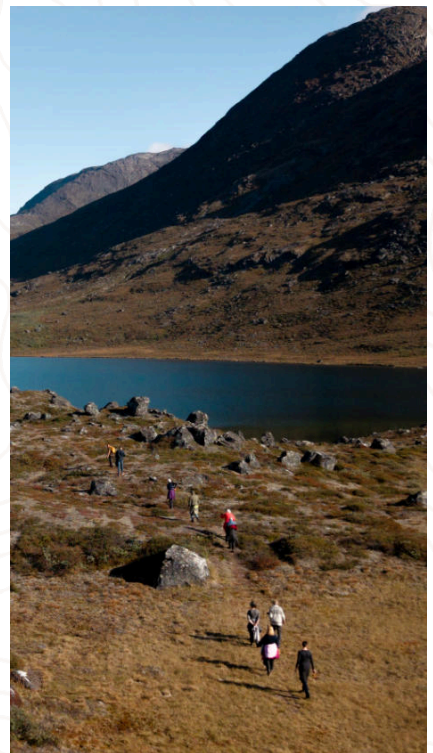
IN A SECLUDED BAY

Camp Kangiusaq is located close to Nuuk, but is isolated in a bay near the icefiord. Go offline and experience a truly secluded stay with us – far from daily disturbances.



MEALS & A BAR

Your stay includes all meals, which consists of breakfast, lunch and dinner. We also have fully licensed bar with a variety of local and international brands.



GUIDED TOURS

During your stay, there's a selection of included tours. Go hiking, fishing or try kayaking! There's something to do every day, besides relaxing.



LUXURY TENTS

Our luxury tents are big enough to stand up in, have actual beds to sleep in, has a proper heater to run all night, and is carefully decorated for a comfy and cozy stay.



TERRACE & TOILET

Each tent is on it's own platform which gives each tent it's very own terrace to enjoy the view all day and night. There's also a toilet for every tent, right next to the tents.



SOLAR POWERED

The camp is partly run on solar, and you can charge your phone and camera (or whatever) at the communal tent – so you'll be able to capture memories when you're staying at the camp.

ACTIVITIES



STAY ACTIVE, AND FULLY ENJOY THE ENTIRE AREA

We have multiple daily guided activities available throughout the stay, which can all be experienced even with a one night stay.

Activities are 90 - 120 minutes long, and with a 2 night stay it's possible to plan a longer guided, or self guided, hike or tour.

The bay is situated perfectly for hiking with multiple viewpoints, icebergs gently floating in and out, gentle waters for kayaking and SUP-boarding and generally enjoying the scenery at any time or place near the camp.

DETAILED ITINERARY

Departure from Nuuk:

- 09.00 Departure from the Tidal Stairs
11.30 Arrival to Camp Kangiusaq (depending on ice)
On arrival – Full introduction to the camp, facilities and activities
12.00 Lunch is served
13.00 Check in

Activities:

- 09.30 – 11.00: Kayak & SUP, and boating/fishing
14.00 – 16.00: Kayak & SUP, hiking, and boating/fishing
17.00 – 19.00: Hiking & boating/fishing

For guests staying 2 nights we will plan one or more longer trips on day 2, the destinations and durations will depend on weather and participants.

Meals:

- 08.00 – 10.00: Breakfast
12.00 – 14.00: Lunch
16.00 – 17.00: 'Hygge' w/ cake & coffee
19.00 – 21.00: Dinner

All meals are included in your stay, we also have a fully licensed bar for those wishing to compliment their stay with local and international beverages, and snacks.

Departure from Camp Kangiusaq

- At breakfast: Pack a lunch from the breakfast buffet for the trip back to Nuuk.
Check out: Before 10.00 or before 09.30 if joining a guided activity.
Departure: 12.00
Arrival at Nuuk: 14.30



THE JOURNEY TO CAMP KANGIUSAQ

Camp Kangiusaq is run by Nuuk Water Taxi, and besides being the same team that manages the camp and it's guests, they also see to the transfer between Nuuk and the camp.

The journey from Nuuk offers an amazing opportunity to experience Nuuk Fiord, which is the second largest fiord in the world. Go from the busy harbour, and escape into the fiord and watch waterfalls, wildlife, an old settlement, mountains and disappear into the icefiord among the icebergs. The transfer is truly an experience on its own!
